

RESOLUTION NO. 38-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE TO SERVE AS THE LOCAL PUBLIC AUTHORITY (LPA) FOR THE MAIN STREET STREETScape PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; Section 5501.03 (C) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) may coordinate the activities of the Department with other appropriate public authorities and enter into contracts with such authorities as necessary to carry out its duties, powers and functions; and

WHEREAS; the Main Street Streetscape Project is a transportation activity eligible to receive federal/state funding; and

WHEREAS; the LPA, City of Painesville, has received funding approval for the project listed above from the Program Manager having responsibility for the federal/state funds involved, and

WHEREAS; it is the mutual desire of both ODOT and the LPA to have the LPA serve as the responsible lead agency for the administration of the project; and

WHEREAS; the City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with ODOT for the above mentioned improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That this Council of the City of Painesville does hereby authorize the City Manager to enter and agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to serve as the Local Public Authority for the implementation of the Main Street Streetscape project.

SECTION II. This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being that unnecessary delay will adversely affect the proper and effective implementation of the downtown master plan and streetscape, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
