

RESOLUTION NO. 39-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH D. B. BENTLEY, INC., INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A 24" NEWELL STREET WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN, WITHOUT FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2010 a leak was discovered at the 24" waterline on Newell Street located under 27 feet of earth; and

WHEREAS, the City needed to repair this transmission main in order to bring it to its normal level of operation; and


WHEREAS, City crews needed outside manpower and equipment to accomplish this repair during an emergency situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO, NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING:


SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with D. B. Bentley, Inc. for a total cost of \$29,937.50 plus any additional costs associated with any and all ensuing change orders, for emergency repairs to a 24" Water Transmission Main without formal advertising and bidding in accordance with the provision of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and its outlying utility customers, the emergency being the immediate necessity to repair a severely damaged waterline that services numerous customers, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
