

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS FOR WATERLINE REPLACEMENTS ON BUTTON AVENUE, WILLIAMS STREET, LEVAN DRIVE, WOOD STREET, HILLSIDE DRIVE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I - That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for Waterline Replacements on Button Avenue, Williams Street, Levan Drive, Wood Street, and Hillside Drive.

SECTION II - That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and for the customers in Painesville Township served by our water system, the emergency being the immediate necessity to replace aging waterlines, the continued use of which could lead to frequent and costly repairs, and therefore this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its passage.
