

RESOLUTION NO. 41-10

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE GRANT FROM  
THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL  
RESOURCES, NATURE WORKS PROGRAM and  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville submitted an initial application in February of 2010 to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for funds to renovate and restore the pond in Kiwanis Recreation Park;

**WHEREAS**, ODNR has accepted that application and committed to provide assistance in the amount of Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Five dollars (\$19,105.00) to be used to provide material to restore the pond;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville has agreed to match said grant through in-kind contributions, specifically the labor and equipment to perform the necessary work associated with the restoration.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:**

SECTION I. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the Nature Works Program for Kiwanis Recreation Park Pond Restoration Project.

SECTION II. This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate need to submit the necessary paperwork for the grant application to begin the project this fall to insure completion by the December 2011 deadline, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
