A RESOLUTION ADOPTING
THE 14th EDITION OF THE AMERICAN PUBLIC POWER ASSOCIATION
SAFETY MANUAL

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville recognizes the importance of workplace safety and the safety of our employees; and

WHEREAS, the American Public Power Association's Safety Manual is the premier source for safety compliance information and standards.

WHEREAS, the updated version in this 14th edition includes user friendly formats, revised to follow current OSHA and NESC standards, as well as several new sections, including a Lock Out/Tag Out Step-by-Step Switching Procedure.

WHEREAS, Some of the revised and expanded sections include: Clothing, Confined or Enclosed Spaces, Work on Energized Cables, Work on De-Energized Cables, Work on Energized Lines and Equipment, Eye and Face Protection, Climbing and Working on Poles, Grounding, and Tree Trimming.

WHEREAS, the Painesville City Council recognizes its commitment to provide workplace safety and adopts the 14th edition of the American Public Power Association safety manual to be used in conjunction with the City of Painesville's safety manual by employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That this Council, for itself, and on behalf of the Administration and citizens of the City of Painesville, hereby adopts the 14th edition American Public Power Associations Safety Manual.

SECTION II. That this resolution shall be entered upon the permanent record of the City of Painesville.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
