RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PUBLIC LANDS TO FILE AN APPLICATION AS A CO-APPLICANT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREA-WIDE COORDINATING AGENCY (NOACA) FOR FUNDS THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE (TLCI) PLANNING GRANT FOR THE CENTRAL LAKE COUNTY LAKEFRONT CONNECTIVITY PLAN ASSOCIATED WITH LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT, LAKE METROPARKS, LAKETRAN, CITY OF MENTOR, VILLAGE OF GRAND RIVER, VILLAGE OF FAIRPORT HARBOR, PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP, AND THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE

**WHEREAS**, multiple transportation and pedestrian-friendly plans exist, but deficiencies exist within City of Painesville and Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville is a member of the Central Lake County Lakefront Connectivity Planning Task Force convened by the Lake County General Health District and the initial assessment concluded that while many independent transportation and pedestrian plans exist, there is a lack of integration between municipalities and connectivity throughout the region; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) planning grant will permit the Task Force to study and evaluate transportation improvements and alternatives that will support future development, success and economic sustainability of mixed use pedestrian friendly connections within and between Lake County communities; and


**WHEREAS**, the Lake County General Health District has resolved to file an application, as the lead applicant, for \$75,000.00 with the Northeast Ohio Area-wide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) for federal funds for the planning funds through Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) Planning Grant to study and evaluate transportation and pedestrian linkages associated with the Central Lake County Lakefront Connectivity Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:**


**Section I.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to be a co-applicant in the application with the Northeast Ohio Area-wide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) for federal funds for the planning funds through Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) Planning Grant to study and evaluate transportation and pedestrian linkages associated with the Central Lake County Lakefront Connectivity Plan and commit up to \$5000.00 local match of funds if awarded.

**Section II.** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peach, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the continuance of the daily activities of the municipal operation and therefore, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
