

RESOLUTION NO. 6-16


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE AWARDING OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW BUILDING AT THE STORRS STREET COMPLEX AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for constructing a new building at the Storrs Street Complex that will house City vehicles and City employees that are currently in the buildings at the Storrs Street Complex in the City of Painesville with specifications on file in the Office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to maintain City operations and therefore, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its passage.
