**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING
PAINESVILLE AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE
2014 NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION OF THE YEAR
MORLEY LIBRARY**

WHEREAS, Morley Library was chosen as the Painesville Area Chamber of Commerce 2014 Non-Profit Organization of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Morley Library was established as a temperance library and reading room by the local Women's Temperance Union in 1878; today they provides a myriad of services to our community; and

WHEREAS, for generations, Morley Library has outstandingly met or exceeded the standard of improving the quality of life in the community and for others; and

WHEREAS, under the direction of Mary Frances Burns since 1994, Morley Library continues to flourish as one of Painesville areas most vital community resources; and

WHEREAS, from the words of the Downtown Painesville Organization "Morley Library shall be a community resource, available to all, contributing to the quality of life in its service area by: providing information for life-long learning and recreation in an organized, professional manner; extending outreach to encourage Library use; and serve as a focal point for the community"; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Painesville have directly benefited from Morley Library's programs and services such as library cards, material reserves and renewals, a drive-up window and book drop, delivery to the homebound, a computer center, as well as a variety of informative and entertainment programs in their meeting rooms; and

WHEREAS, the Painesville Area Chamber of Commerce will recognize the contributions of Morley Library on January 13, 2014 by honoring it with the designation of "2014 Non-Profit Organization of the Year".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That this Council, for itself, and on behalf of the Administration and citizens of the City of Painesville, hereby recognizes Morley Library and expresses appreciation for its continued presence, service and its dedication to the community.

SECTION II. That this resolution shall be entered upon the permanent record of the City of Painesville, and a certified copy hereof shall be presented to Morley Library.


SECTION III. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
