

ORDINANCE NO. 2-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 141.02 OF THE PAINESVILLE CODE OF 1998 RELATING TO ELIGIBILITY FOR EMPLOYMENT IN THE PAINESVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:


SECTION I. SECTION 141.02 OF THE PAINESVILLE CODE OF 1998 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 141.02 - ELIGIBILITY FOR EMPLOYMENT


NO PERSON SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT AS A POLICEMAN OR POLICEWOMAN IN AN OPEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION UNLESS HE OR SHE HAS REACHED THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) AND HAS NOT ATTAINED THE AGE OF THIRTY-SEVEN (37). IN THE CASE OF A LATERAL EXAMINATION NO PERSON SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN APPOINTMENT AS A POLICEMAN OR POLICEWOMAN UNLESS HE OR SHE HAS REACHED THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) AND HAS NOT ATTAINED THE AGE OF FORTY-TWO (42).

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE NECESSARY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY, AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, THE EMERGENCY BEING THAT IN ORDER TO BRING THE PAINESVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT UP TO DESIRED STRENGTH IT IS NECESSARY AND DESIRABLE TO BE ABLE TO EMPLOY PERSONS IN THE CASE OF AN OPEN EXAMINATION UP TO AGE THIRTY-SEVEN (37) AND IN THE CASE OF A LATERAL EXAMINATION UP TO AGE FORTY-TWO (42); AND THEREFORE, THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE.
