

ORDINANCE NO. 20-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 933.19 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO WATER RATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That Section 933.19 of the Codified Ordinances of Painesville, Ohio, 1998 is hereby amended repealing Section (a - e) as follows:

933.19 SCHEDULE OF WATER SERVICE RATES.

(a) For the purpose of meeting the expenses of operating and maintaining the water treatment plant and water distribution system, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to charge and collect monthly for potable water in accordance with the following rates effective ~~March 1, 2011~~ January 1, 2020:



(e)-(f) Exceptions. Existing rates established by agreements or contracts which differ from those established above shall continue for the term of such agreement or contracts.


