AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND COLLECTION OF MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX IN THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 191 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Painesville, Ohio provides for collection of Municipal Income Tax; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to provide an expedient and efficient means for collection of said Municipal Income Tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement for Participation In a Regional Council of Governments to provide for the administration and collection of Municipal Income Tax.

SECTION II. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION III. That this resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity for the City of Painesville to enter into an agreement with Regional Income Tax Agency to administer the income tax laws of the City of Painesville and to act as its agent in the collection of said taxes and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
