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A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WATER LINE CROSSING KELLOGG CREEK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for the replacement of the water line crossing Kellogg Creek, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the customers of the City of Painesville Water Department, the emergency being the immediate necessity to replace the water line crossing Kellogg Creek just south of Route 84 to insure reliable flow to approximately 300 households and to maintain pressure in a portion of the Concord District.
