Goals

- Purpose

 - Improve the overall quality of the City's infrastructure
 - Fulfill the goals set by City Council.
 - Fulfill the goal of the 2006 Comprehensive Plan created to continue the growth and development of the City
 - Fulfill the goal of the 2015 Central Lake County Lakefront Connectivity Plan

Overview

- In 1994, City Council passed Ordinance #35-94, which requires property owners to maintain sidewalks
- City Council and City Staff agreed to resume the sidewalk repair and rehabilitation program for properties with existing sidewalks



Overview

- Administration
 - 'X', white paint= Home Owner's Responsibility
 - 'O', white paint= City's Responsibility
 - Administered and enforced by the Engineering Department



Permit Guidelines

- Permit Fees
 - Sidewalk permit fee is \$45.00
- Two Inspections Will Take Place:
 - A pre-pour inspection will be performed to check the depth of concrete and the subgrade.
 - A final inspection will be performed once restoration is completed.
 - Inspections can be scheduled concurrently; although the contractor/homeowner assumes all risks should the form inspection fail.
