system for discharge of trucked waste, which includes, but is not limited to, the payment of all charges and fees
assessed to the Principle pursuant to these chapters for the use of or damage to the sewer system.

Surety is relieved of any further liability. The said Surety will be liable for loss occurring up to the effective date of
said cancellation notice, in event, to exceed the penalty of this bond.
