

ORDINANCE NO. 28-17

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE AMENDED APPROPRIATIONS AND TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL INTER-FUND TRANSFERS AND ADVANCES FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, STATE OF OHIO DURING THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017, AND AMENDING THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2017 OPERATING BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That the appropriations, transfers and advances as outlined in the attached Exhibit A are hereby authorized and incorporated into this ordinance as if written herein.



That this ordinance is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide additional funds so that sufficient budget authority is available to address these expenditures and to ensure that the funds listed do not end the year with a deficit, and, therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
